But this is a serious mistake. Last year, 60%* of businesses in Europe and the USA reported suffering a data breach due to insecure printing.

If left unsecured, an MFP can be a serious threat, since it is simultaneously connected to the internal network as well as the internet. This creates a vector through which cyber-criminals can infiltrate your private network.

And the threat level is rising. Despite being a smaller market, Canada had the third most cyber incidents in the world last year!²

In the face of this danger, it's more important than ever to secure every part of your IT ecosystem - especially your MFP.

At Ricoh, we've always been aware of the risks, and we're committed to helping customers avoid them. We operate on the basis of our CIA principle:

- Confidentiality – Access to information and documents must be restricted to trusted people only. This reduces the risk they will fall into the wrong hands.
- Integrity – It's vital to maintain the integrity of documents as they pass through the management system. This means locking documents in transit or storage so they can't be edited by unauthorized individuals.
- Availability – Security doesn't mean inaccessibility. You need to be able to reach the documents you need whenever, wherever and for as long as required.

We apply CIA to all our devices and processes. We don't fall into the trap of thinking of security as a stand-alone topic. It's integral to everything we do, and is part of every product and service by design. Ultimately, this gives you the freedom to innovate and operate at the speed you choose, without having to worry about how data is secured.

Protecting sensitive information

Our new range of devices are in-built with best in class security features. This starts with card authentication, which prevents sensitive documents from being viewed, copied or sent by unauthorised users.

We further protect sensitive documents with the Streamline NX secure release feature that restricts access to print output to the document owners only.

Our Data Overwrite Security System (DOSS) is designed to overwrite the areas of the hard drive used for image processing after each printing, copy, scan or fax job.

Maintaining the highest standards

Ricoh offers a broad line of devices that have been certified as conforming to the IEEE2600 security standard.

On top of this, our proprietary Ricoh-only operating system (OS) helps provide control and insulation from OS-specific threats that attack systems using more common machine languages.

A comprehensive range of services wrap around the other layers of security. We work with expert cybersecurity partners to offer consultancy and managed services to assist customers with monitoring, optimising and managing their document and information security.

Our intelligent MFP devices have one of the lowest energy consumption levels in the industry, both in typical weekly energy consumption (TEC) and actual power consumption.

This is due to energy efficient features such as ultra-low sleep mode triggered by a Default Auto Off timer after the device has been idle for anywhere between 1 to 6 minutes. The super-fast recovery time makes sure there is no impact on end-user productivity.

This EcoMode functionality reduces the power consumption, running costs and carbon footprint of the device. But don't worry – a quick recovery time means there will be no impact on your productivity, since your device will wake up from sleep mode the second you need it.

A smarter use of resources means freedom to build a sustainable future

As part of our commitment to a circular economy, Ricoh has produced this range of intelligent MFPs using sustainable materials where possible.

Our Equipment, Toner Bottle and Cartridge Recycling Programs ensure we protect the environment, use resources efficiently and reduce needless waste. In fact, for every Ricoh machine that is recycled by Ricoh, 98.4% of the machine is recovered in the recycling process. We consistently aim to introduce alternative raw materials such as post-consumer waste plastic, bio-based plastic and scrap metal in our device components to replace the oil-based alternatives.

Smart Support functionality means less engineer visits and so less travel is needed over the lifetime of a device, reducing the carbon footprint.

And of course, our scalable intelligence range has an exceptionally long life cycle. This supports a highly sustainable business model, as the device can be updated to grow along with your business – minimizing the need to replace hardware.

Printing has an unfair reputation for being bad for the environment, on account of the paper that is used.
